Evade and Eliminate

Purpose: To knock the other three teams out in separate four-person

dodgeball rounds.

Set-up: Four teams at the four corners of a basketball court with

dodgeballs in the middle.

Play: The four teams will be numbered and line up in a similar

fashion at the four corners of a basketball court. When a number is called, that particular player will run to the opposite basketball pole and then to the center of the court. The players will then pick up one ball and proceed to play dodgeball until one person is left. The players may only use one dodgeball at a time, may deflect with a ball in their hands, and may also catch a thrown ball. A caught ball results in the thrower being called out. (A ball must be thrown. It cannot be used simply to tag a person out. Also, players are not allowed to hit above the shoulders with

the dodgeball.)

Variations: Different numbers of dodgeballs

Different placement of dodgeballs More than one number being called

Stunt being performed before getting a dodgeball (make a lay-up, ball tossed in trash can, frisbee knocking tennis ball off cone, etc.)
