CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Each floor is numbered below.

The straight lines are walls built floor to the top of the next level.

The squares are opening (either to below to above). Follow the letters to see the passage of travel. Holes can be cut with odd shapes (not just squares), but wide enough for 17" by 17" minimum. Our first hole after the entrance on Level 2 was the smallest of the whole route.

The dimensions of the Box Cave are 10w x 10h x 10d. Each level is 24" above the other. 2x2 sections of wood are used to hold maze walls in place (they are sanded down to remove sharp edges).

The outside material is 1x4 treated wood spaced 1" for various reasons.

One side of the box was built so that a separate frame was used so that by only removing 8 screws the whole wall can be removed for safety and maintenance purposes.

Use creativity on the wall angles to create fun (tight) spaces. (Picture top right)
